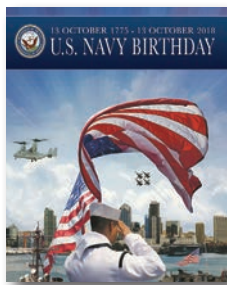
MIRAMAR AIR SHOW
